**Schedule:**

The workshop begins at 8:30am (continental breakfast available at 8:00am) on Tuesday, March 8, 2005 and continues through 1:00pm on Saturday, March 12. It will take place at the Exploratorium, located in the Palace of Fine Arts at 3601 Lyon St. in San Francisco. Participants are expected to attend all sessions and should notify us immediately if unable to participate fully through the length of the workshop.

**Hotel Reservations:**

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Coventry Motor Inn (1901 Lombard St.) under the group name "Institute for Inquiry". **The group number is 1052.** The rate for the room is \$79 (double or single) per night plus tax. **Please call the Inn by February 2 at (415) 567-1200 to reserve your room/s.** Within a week of making the reservation you'll need to secure the room by giving a credit card number or sending a check to the hotel.

**Workshop Fee:**
